

PAPER PLATE OBSTACLE COURSE

SUGGESTED MONTH / EVENT	SUGGESTED GRADE
October/Halloween or November/Thanksgiving	All grades

OBJECTIVE: Create an obstacle course on a paper plate.

MATERIALS (per student)

- paper plate
- pompom (lower grades) or marbles (upper grades)
- pipe cleaners
- monster/pumpkin templates
- tape
- scissors (to cut pipe cleaners and templates)

INSTRUCTIONS

Part 1: Templates

- 1. Distribute 2-4 of the monster/pumpkin templates to each student.
- 2. Cut on the dotted lines.
- 3. Fold on the solid lines.
- 4. Connect A to B (no overlapping) and form a triangle.
- 5. Tape where A meets B.

Part 2: Building the obstacle course

- 1. Bend both ends of the pipe cleaners (like a tail; see photo).
- 2. Tape both "tails" of each pipe cleaner to the plate. Make sure that the pompom or marble can fit under the arch.
- 3. Tape the bottom part of the monster/pumpkin triangle to the plate.

CHALLENGE

- Roll the pompom (or marble) from one arch to another <u>without</u> hitting the monster/pumpkin. In 30 seconds, count points:
 - +1 point = under the arch
 - -1 point = touch the monster/pumpkin OR Make Your Own Game Rules!
